Rev. John Gregory Hooks is a native of Lake Placid, FL. He attended Bethune-Cookman College, Daytona Beach, FL and is an alumnus of Saint Thomas Aquinas College, Sparkill, N.Y. Pastor Hooks also received his Masters of Pastoral Studies degree

at New York Theological Seminary, New York, N.Y.
